January & February, 2019
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BERNINA Club January Project: Composition Notebook cover:

Cotton fabric; sub cut to: Fat quarter, cut to (2) 16 3/4" x 10 3/4" (exterior panel, lining panel)
Fat eighth, cut to (4) 6" x 10 3/4" (cover panels) , Scraps, cut to (2) 6" x 5" (small pocket)
Scraps, cut to (2) 6" x 7" (large pocket),
Fusible woven interfacing (16 3/4" x 10 3/4") & (1) 16 3/4" x 10 3/4"
Pins , 1" elastic 2" long, Polyester thread (Mettler Metrosene), Size 80 Jeans needle
Sewing machine, Patchwork Foot #97D with moveable seam guide
Edgestitch Foot #10D

Basket weave quilt block: New Ways with Jelly Rolls book, 1 jelly roll, 1 3/8 accent fabric, 2/14 background fabric. 90 degree triangle ruler.

Sassy Striped Zipper Bag: Embroidery machine, 5x7 hoop, 2 fat quarters, 1 cork or vinyl piece, D ring, 9" zipper, scraps of batting, tearaway or poly mesh stabilizer plus embroidery thread to match, Sue Overy Design's pattern/CD, sassy striped zipper bag.

Beginning Sewing: Your sewing machine in good working order or you may rent one of ours for \$15.00. Basic sewing supplies (See Below), notions and fabric for your project. Come in before class and we will help you select your fabric.

Go! Out On A Limb Notebook Cover: Fabric (the sample used Batik fabrics)—You can substitute the Pink, Purple & Teal for what you want. Look at the picture to get an idea of what you will be making, Pink: Fat Eighth or Scrap, Purple: Fat Eighth or Scrap, Teal: 1/3 Yard, Green: Fat Eighth, Orange: Fat Eighth or Scrap, Browns (5 assorted shades—one dark): Fat Eighths or Scraps, White: 1/4 Yard, Lining: 16x11, Muslin: 20x15,
Batting: 20x15, Fusible Web: 1/3 yard, Grosgrain Ribbon—1 yard coordinating (3/4" or 1" wide) (Sub cut: 2—18" lengths)
Composition Notebook/Journal (7 1/2" x 9 3/4") (available where office supplies are sold) (not necessary for class)
All usual sewing supplies, including pins, wonder clips, thread, rotary cutter, rulers, cutting mat, seam ripper, and craft iron and small ironing mat if you have them will be helpful.

Shop Hop Owl Quilt: All your kits you have collected. Your favorite fusible product (we have several to choose from), basic sewing supplies and an array of thread colors you would like to use.

Diva Wallet: Diva Wallet Pattern, Fat Quarters (Main and Accent—or scraps will work (see pattern for sizes) (I like to have at least two accent colors besides my main cotton/batik color), 1/4 yard of Pellon 808 Décor Bond or similar 44" W fusible interfacing, 1 Metal Diva Wallet Frame 7 1/2" or 8", and Extra Small Phillips Head Screwdriver, at least 7" All Purpose polyester zipper (longer is okay too, you can cut them), fabric glue or double sided basting tape of some sort, plus all usual sewing supplies, including pins, wonder clips, rotary cutter, rulers (particularly 8 1/2 inch square ruler), cutting mat, chalk pencil, seam ripper, craft iron and small ironing mat if you have them will be helpful.

Beginning quilting: Book: Start Quilting with Alex Anderson, fabric yardage for Rail Fence pattern. A 6"x 24" ruler, rotary cutter, cutting mat, 1/4" foot plus basic sewing supplies. To do before class: Press all fabrics with Best Press.

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Create Your Ruler Work Designs For Your Quilts: BERNINA ruler set, pencils & tracing paper (Usually available at Staples or Michaels, best size is 11x14 but if not available a smaller size can be used). Rulers should have white paper backing removed.

BARCELONA SKIRT: Amy Butler Barcelona skirt pattern & supplies as specified in pattern plus basic sewing supplies.

Basic sewing supplies includes: sewing machine, scissors, pins, tape measure, thread to match. Small iron and pressing mat if you have one
We will provide sergers for finish work on a lot of the projects.
Be sure to bring your sewing machine foot control and power cord and basic sewing foot.
